Acknowledge of Dancer Code of Conduct September 2015 – August 2016

Please read the information below regarding your expected behavior at our danceout/show performances and ANY level of Feisanna. Discuss these guidelines with your child and direct any outstanding questions to the Danceout Committee, Parent Director, or Molly. Every student represents the entire school. If there are any major problems the dancer's privileges may be taken away.

DANCEOUTS/SHOWS:

- Dancers should remain quiet while waiting and keep chatting to a minimum.
- Dancer should pay attention and follow direction of the parents that are helping.
- There will be NO -HORSE PLAY.
- Dancers should listen for line-up and placement.
- Dancers should be respectful to all parents, teachers and guests.
- Older dancers are expected to assist younger dancers in line, with shoe changes, practicing their dances or other requests made by a member of the danceout committee.
- Every dancer should be responsible for their own belongings (shoes, uniform, water, etc.).
- When using the dressing areas the dancer should get dressed quickly and leave the room so not to disturb other dancers.

All of the dancer's belongings should be neatly organized when at the danceout.

FEISANNA:

- Competition is a privilege and should be fun, but there are rules within the Francis Academy that are required on how dancers present themselves when competing.
- All dancers, no matter what placement or level, should congratulate the other dancers in their competition.
- Competition within the school is frowned upon. Francis Academy Dancers are expected to support their classmates and congratulate each other's success.
- Dancers must be respectful to their parents at all times (when they are helping you get ready, helping you practice, waiting for results, etc.).
- NO OUTBURST or TANTRUMS, dancing should be fun!
- When receiving an award the dancer should be in full costume and smile.
